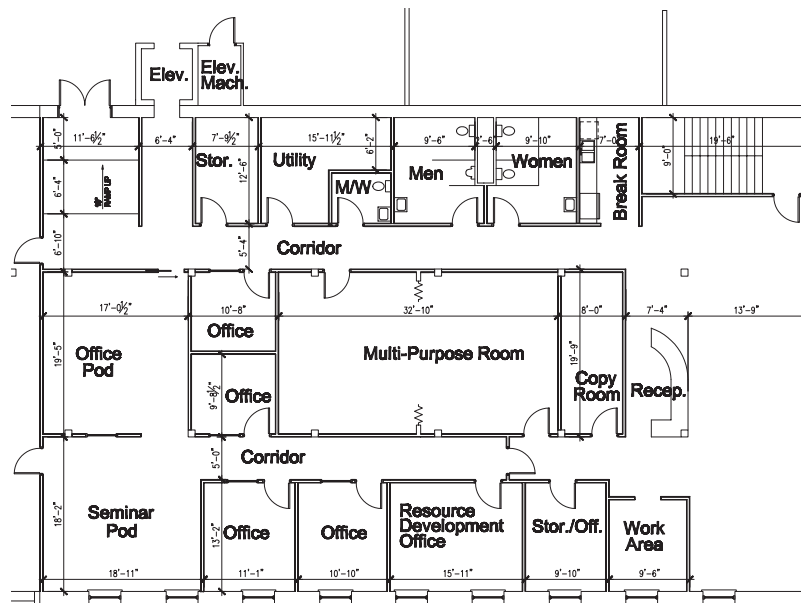
The funds we have raised thus far have been put to use. The 1800 building was purchased at the close of 2005. Renovation to the exterior began the next summer. The roof has been replaced. New windows have been installed. The building has been painted. The interior has been gutted. The sprinkler system has been up-dated.

We are ready to begin building out phase one of the interior. Phase one will include offices for PPC staff / a multi purpose conference area computer work stations / a seminar pod / two small conference rooms and a community "living room"

You can help finish the renovation of phase one. Your gift will help put this "Almost-Like-New" facility to good use.

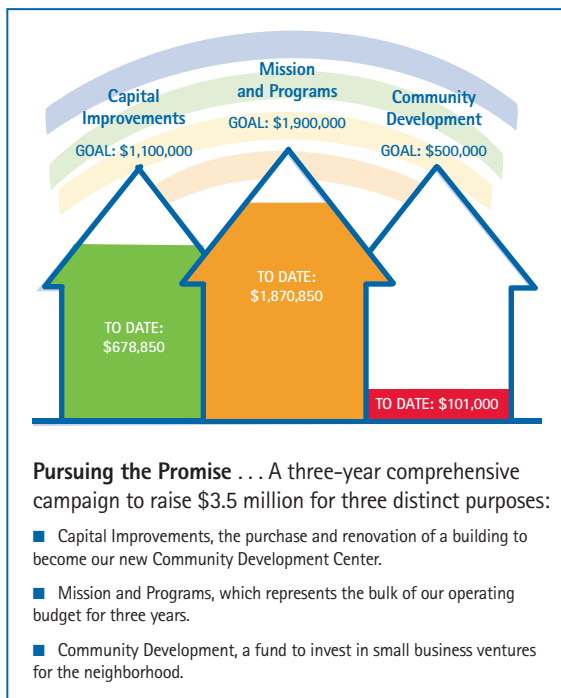
